

The Antarctic Dream is a Dutch built ice-reinforced vessel and served under the name Piloto Pardo for the Chilean Navy. The vessel was rebuilt as an unrestricted, worldwide passenger vessel and was completely refurbished in July 2005. This handsome vessel features a spacious dining room / observation lounge, bar, lecture room, fitness room plus sauna, and passenger bridge.



Capacity: Antarctica: 78 Guests / Arctic: 84 Guests (inside Twin cabins offered).

Cabins: All cabins have a desk, TV and an inter-cabin/bridge/pursers office phone service. Satellite email and phone service are available in the library. Hair dryers are fitted as standard in the bathrooms. Sockets take thin round pin plugs. All Cabins have private ensuite facilities.

- Twin private inside :3 (no porthole or window) :2 with queen beds 1 with two single beds
- Twin private: 19 (small porthole) :11 with queen beds 8 with two single beds
- Superior: 16 (large window) : 6 with queen beds 10 with two single beds
- Suite: 4 (large windows to two sides, bath) : 3 with queen beds 1 with two single beds

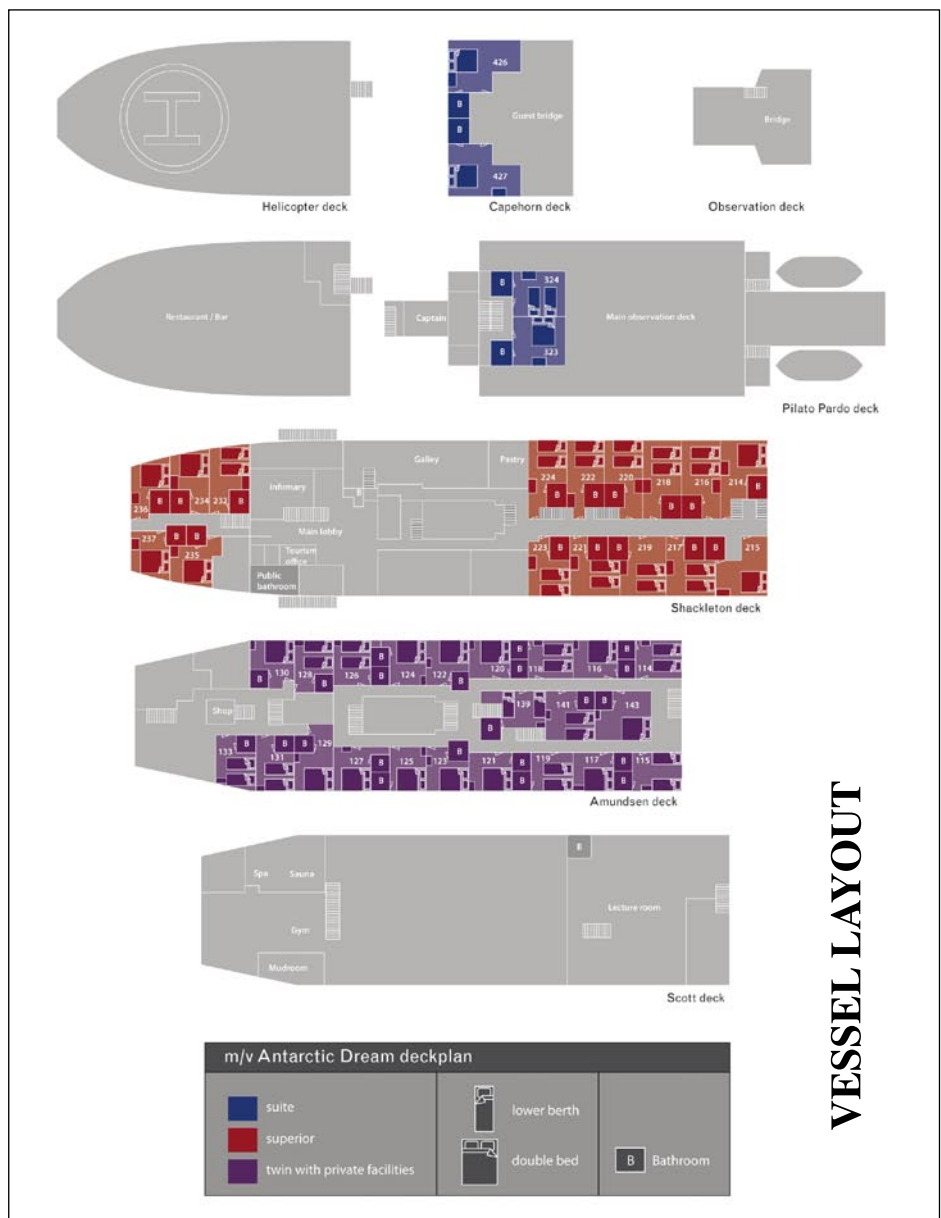
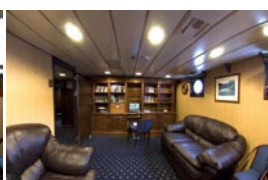
