

This ship was reconfigured in 2008 to operate as an Adventure Ship with clean, crisp Scandinavian styling and an excellent reputation. Built to sail the ice-choked waters of Greenland; it is a ship that offers more comfort than some but retains a relatively low passenger capacity.

**Capacity:** 68 guests in comfortable triple, twin & superior cabins and suites.

- 37 outside cabins, all with private facilities.
- Spacious dining room, table-service lunch and dinner with main course choices from a changing daily menu; cakes served in mid-afternoon.
- Glass-enclosed observation lounge and presentation room.
- Lounge and bar, open late morning, afternoon and evening with a wide selection of wines and spirits; coffee, tea available all day and a library with a collection of polar-themed books.
- Clinic with licensed doctor.
- Exercise room. \*Please note: there is no passenger elevator between decks.
